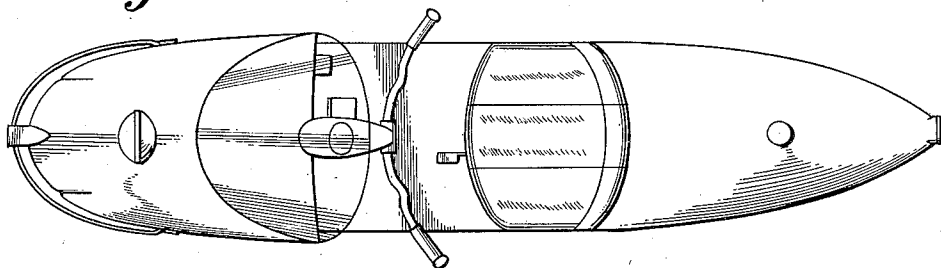

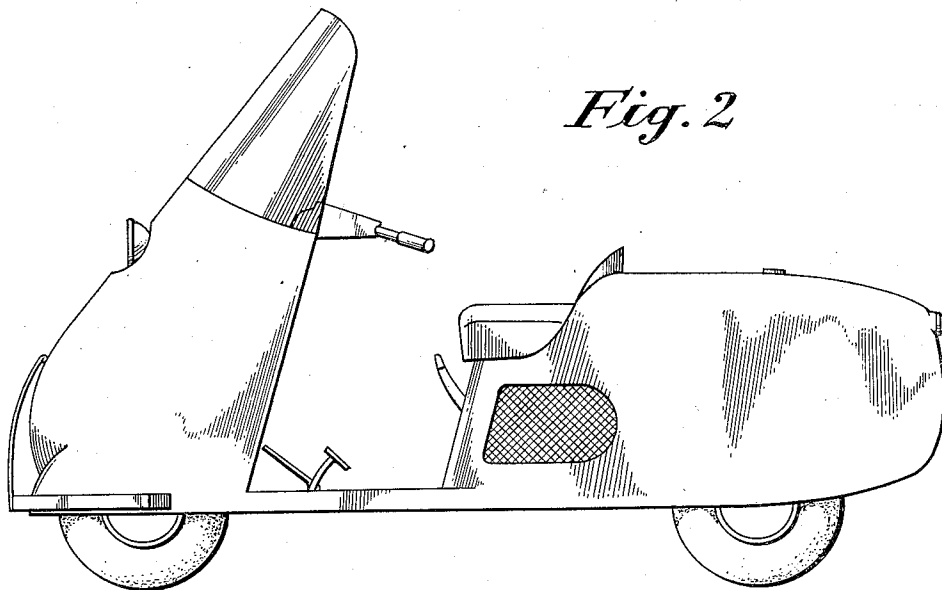

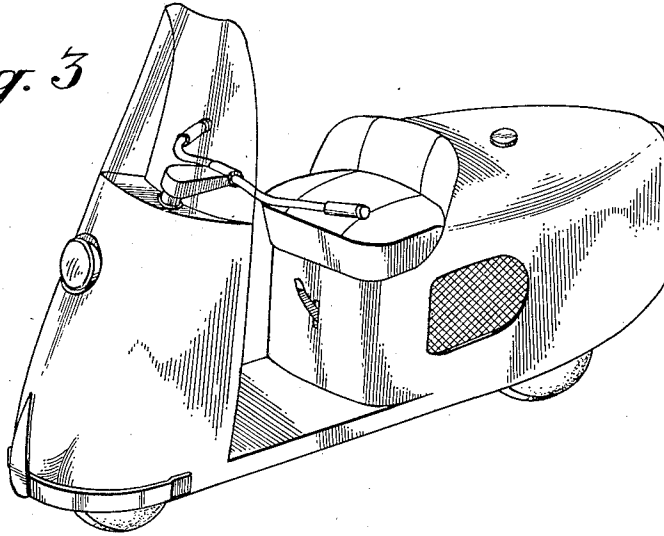

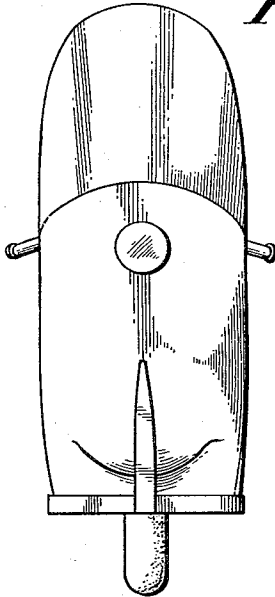

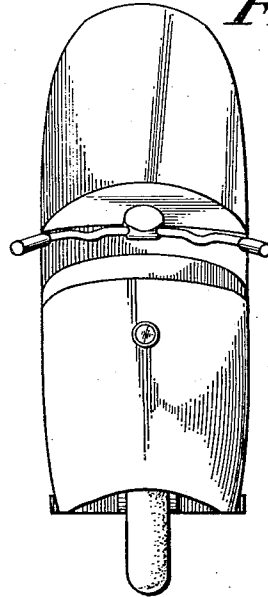

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Kenneth McLellan, a citizen of the United States, residing at Monrovia, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Motor Scooter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a motor scooter, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view;

Fig. 3 is a perspective view;

Fig. 4 is a front elevational view; and

Fig. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The body of the vehicle is symmetrical about a vertical plane along its major axis.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a motor scooter, as shown and described.
